### General

- Barhale confirmed that neither Farley lane or Heath end Road would be used for laydown

### 1. Communication

- A draft of the newsletter has been created, there is a version tailored for Romsley, which includes the content prepared by the residents committee. This will be forwarded to the committee for review.

### 2. Noise Level Baseline Surveys

- Consultants have now been appointed, Hepworth Acoustics
- Details were provided on the approach Hepworth will take to carrying out the baseline assessments, which will commence shortly

### 3. Construction Traffic on Dayhouse Bank

- It was confirmed that there has been a 90% improvement with vans/lorries using Dayhouse Bank and a special thanks to Arthur for his help with this issue. Arthur helped to trace the destination of the vehicles, which were found to be travelling on a different site. However this was followed up with the site concerned with a positive result.

### 4. Highways

- Concerns remain re the Councils understanding of the traffic speed and potential issues with Putney Lane
- It was confirmed that there will be extensive signage to advise drivers of the site entrance
