2. Each competitive entry is only accepted on the distinct understanding that it has been grown or made by the competitor.
3. Any Exhibits not to Schedule will not be judged.
4. Entries are accepted under one name only.
5. No exhibiter shall be allowed in the showroom whilst judging is in progress unless that person is acting as an official or steward of the show.
6. All closed classes are for Romsley and Hunnington residents only.
7. Prize money will be 1<sup>st</sup> £5, 2<sup>nd</sup> £3, 3<sup>rd</sup> £2.
8. Prize money will only be paid out on the day of the show, and only on presentation of a valid prize card.
9. All exhibits to remain until 3.00 pm.
10. All Recipes supplied must be followed.

### **Cup Cakes Recipe**

- 125 g (4oz) butter  
125 g (4oz) self raising flour  
125 g (4oz) caster sugar
- 2 large eggs, beaten  
vanilla essence (optional)

Cream the butter and sugar until light and creamy, add eggs a little at a time and essence if using, beat well then gently fold in sifted flour.

Transfer mixture into cupcake paper cases. Bake in preheated oven at 180-190c/350-375f/gas mark 5 for 20 to 25 minutes.

Cool on wire rack and decorate with a **Flower Theme**. Submit your best 3 cakes.

### **Fruit Scones Recipe**

- 225g (8oz) self-raising flour  
55g (2oz) butter  
55g (2oz) caster sugar
- pinch of Salt  
55g (2oz) currants or sultanas  
Milk to mix

Sift flour and salt into a mixing bowl, rub in the butter. Stir in the fruit, sugar and then gradually the milk to give a soft dough.

Turn the dough out onto a floured surface, knead very lightly. Roll out and use a 6/7cm (2½ ins) cutter. Transfer to a greased baking tray and brush with a little milk. Bake in 230c, 425f or gas mark 7 oven for approx. 10mins. Cool on a wire rack. Submit your 3 best scones.

## **Victoria Sandwich Recipe**

175g (6oz) butter  
175g (6oz) self raising flour  
175g (6oz) caster sugar

3 large eggs, beaten

Cream the butter and sugar until light and creamy, add eggs a little at a time and beat well, gently fold in sifted flour. Place the mixture into two 20cm diameter greased sponge tins.

Bake in preheated oven 160-180c/325-350f/gas mark 4 for 25 to 30mins. Allow to cool, fill with jam or butter cream.

## **Rice Krispie Cakes Recipe - Children Only**

60g (2oz) unsalted butter  
1x100g bar milk or dark chocolate

3 tablespoons golden syrup  
90g (3oz) Rice Krispies

With adult supervision melt the chocolate slowly in a microwave. Cut the butter up into small pieces and add to the chocolate, stir until the butter is melted. Add the syrup, stir until mixed into the chocolate mixture. Add the Rice Krispies and stir gently into the chocolate mixture. Spoon into paper cases. Leave to cool. Now decorate. Choose three to exhibit.
