General

1. Communication

2. Noise Level Baseline Surveys

- Consultants have now been appointed, Hepworth Acoustics

3. Construction Traffic on Dayhouse Bank

• It was confirmed that there has been a 90% improvement with vans/lorries using Dayhouse Bank and a special thanks to Arthur for his help with this issue. Arthur helped to trace the destination of the vehicles, which were found to be travelling on a different site. However this was followed up with the site concerned with a positive result.

4. Highways

- Concerns remain re the Councils understanding of the traffic speed and potential issues with Putney Lane
- It was confirmed that there will be extensive signage to advise drivers of the site entrance
